

FAST TRACK APPLICATION FAQ FOR STUDENTS:

1. What is PG Fast Track?

It is a faster application route for current final year undergraduate students which does not require you to provide a personal statement/ reference and takes less time to be processed.

2. Can I apply for PGCE courses via Fast Track?

3. What if my chosen course is not available via Fast Track?

That's fine, you will need to apply directly to the University of Greenwich. You can find the application form here: <https://gre.ac.uk/olaf>

4. How many Fast Track applications can I make?

You can apply for one course only. If you have applied previously and changed your mind, you will have to change the course you have applied for.

5. What grade do I need to have to apply through Fast Track scheme?

This may vary depending on the course you're applying for, but for most courses, you will need to have at least 2:2 or above. For some courses you may be required to complete an interview.

6. How do I apply for a postgraduate course via Fast Track scheme?

7. If I am a recent graduate, can I still apply for a Fast Track scheme?

If you are a recent class of 2022 Greenwich graduate, you can apply for postgraduate courses starting in September 2023.

8. Can I apply through postgraduate Fast Track if I am an international student?

Yes, you can apply through the Fast Track Scheme. Unfortunately, you will not be able to apply for a Greenwich Postgraduate Scholarship.

9. What do I need to apply for postgraduate Fast Track?

You will need to have your University of Greenwich Student ID and your personal email address.

10. Is there a deadline to apply through Fast Track?

No, there is no deadline to apply for PG Fast Track.

11. How long does it take for Fast Track applications to be processed?

You receive an update within one working day. You can email FastTrack@greenwich.ac.uk at any time with questions or updates on your application.

12. What courses can I apply for?

When filling out the Fast Track form, you will be asked which undergraduate course you are currently studying, once selected you will be given options for PG courses that you would be eligible for based on this information.

GREENWICH POSTGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP FAQ:

1. Can I apply for Greenwich Postgraduate Scholarship if I already have a postgraduate degree?

Unfortunately, you wouldn't qualify for a scholarship if you have studied a postgraduate degree before.

2. How many postgraduate scholarships are available?

There are 75 scholarships available.

3. Can I apply for Greenwich Postgraduate Scholarship if I am an international student?

No, you would have to be a home student or an EU national resident paying home fees

4. What is the eligibility criteria for Greenwich Postgraduate Scholarship?

- Must be a current final year undergraduate student at the University of Greenwich.

- Holding a conditional offer for a postgraduate course with the University.
- Must be predicted a 2:2 or above degree.
- Considered a UK national or an EU national resident in the UK paying home fees.
- Your household income needs to be below £43,000 for this academic year.
- Not already studied a postgraduate degree

5. How do I apply for a postgraduate scholarship?

You will need to complete the online application form here:

6. Can I apply for a scholarship if I have been awarded the Alumni award? Can it be combined with other scholarships/awards?

Unfortunately, no. You can only receive one scholarship from the University. Thus, if you have been awarded the Alumni discount, you wouldn't be able to apply for a Fast Track Scholarship.

7. Can I apply for a scholarship if I have a maintenance loan from SFE?

Yes. However, if you have an undergraduate maintenance loan from Student Finance England, please ensure SFE has consent to share your household income assessment with us.

8. If I am studying part- time, how will the scholarship be awarded?

If you are studying part-time, the award is split across two years. The second payment is made subject to satisfactory progress.

9. Do I need to make a separate application for a scholarship?

Yes, you will need to make a separate application for a scholarship. Please be advised that an offer through the PG Fast Track scheme does not guarantee you an offer for the Greenwich Postgraduate Scholarship.

10. How will my scholarship application be assessed?

After submitting your application, it will then be assessed by a scholarship panel and priority will be given to applicants who met the University Widening Participation Criteria. The panel decision is final and cannot be contested.

11. What happens if I change my course after applying for a Greenwich Postgraduate Scholarship?

If you change to a different programme as specified in the conditional / unconditional offer you may risk having the scholarship and award removed.

12. Are scholarships open to all programmes?

Yes, they are.

13. Are scholarships awarded on a first come first served basis?

Unfortunately, no. You will need to submit 250 words statement about how you have grown whilst with the university and how the scholarship will help you with your postgraduate studies.

14. Can I still apply for a postgraduate scholarship if I have received the full amount of Master's loan (£11,836)?

Yes, you can.

15. What is the deadline to apply for Greenwich Postgraduate Scholarship 2023?

It is Friday, the 30 June 2023.
